The Biblical Chronology confirms the standard result of Egyptology for the end of the 13th dynasty at 1632 B.C.

KJV Genesis 15:13 And he said unto Abram, Know of a surety that thy **seed shall** be a stranger in a land that is not theirs, (and shall serve them; and they shall afflict them) **four hundred years**; 14 And also that nation, whom they shall serve, will I judge: and afterward shall they come out with great substance. 15 And thou shalt go to thy fathers in peace; thou shalt be buried in a good old age. 16 **But in the fourth generation** they shall come hither again: for the iniquity of the Amorites is not yet full.

KJV Exodus 12:40 Now the sojourning of the children of Israel, (who dwelt in Egypt), was **four hundred and thirty years**. 41 And it came to pass at the end of the four hundred and thirty years, even the selfsame day it came to pass, that all the hosts of Yahweh went out from the land of Egypt.

1 Kings 6:1 "And it came to pass in **480th year** of 'going of sons of Israel from land of Egypt', in **the fourth year**, in the **month of Ziv**, the second month, of the reign of Solomon over Israel that he began to build the house of Yahweh"

15 Nisan = Fri, April 11, 1632 B.C. JP. Passover Eaten 4/10 ss Δγ

6 Sivan = Sabbath, May 31, 1632 B.C. JP, Torah Given to Israel. Δγ

Exodus
The 480 years of 1 Kings 6:1 counts the years of independence when Israel was able to celebrate the going out of Egypt at the passover.

KJV Exodus 40:2 On the **first day of the first month** shalt thou set up the tabernacle of the tent of the congregation. (Thursday, April 16, 1631 B.C. JP Δγ)

KJV Numbers 1:1 And the LORD spake unto Moses in the wilderness of Sinai, in the tabernacle of the congregation, **on the first day of the second month** in the second year after they were come out of the land of Egypt. (Sabbath, May 16, 1631 B.C. JP). Δγ correction applied.

KJV Numbers 10:11 And it came to pass **on the twentieth day of the second month, in the second year**, that the cloud was taken up from off the tabernacle of the testimony. (Thur, June 4, 1631 B.C. JP, 7x7+1=50 days after the tabernacle was set up). Δγ correction applied.

All the men 20 years and over were sentenced to die in the wilderness. This shows the age of those 19 years old, who would be the elders of Israel when they entered the land. This gives them a life span of 77 years (7 x 11) before the first rebellion. The left col. shows an estimate of Joshua's age, who was Moses "servant" or "attendant" (Exodus 33:11; n.b. "young" is a mistranslation. The context clearly requires def. #2, BDB.)

KJV Deuteronomy 2:14 And the space in which we came from Kadeshbarnea, until we were come over the brook Zered, was **thirty and eight years**: until all the generation of the men of war were wasted out from among the host, as Yahweh sware unto them.

Sin of the Ten Spies
The conquest began at the end of 38 years after the rebellion of the ten spies, which was half way through the 40th year in the wilderness. So 39.5 - 38 = 1.5. The sin of the ten spies was 1 1/2 years after the Exodus, which is the fall of the 2nd year.
