"7. (346) Now when Alexander was dead, the government was parted among his successors ... (347) ... About this time it was that Jaddua the high priest died, and Onias his son took the high priesthood." (Josephus, Antiquites, 11.8.7).

n.b. The Macedonians did not use the accession year system (Parker). This weighs in favor of the Greeks using the spring of 312 as the start of the A.S.  
n.b. With Alexander the well-known device of the "accession year" disappears from Babylonian usage (Parker).

The battle of Gaza → Seleucus' reign antedated to late summer

"By all that has been said, the question is not yet settled as to whether the era of our book [1 Maccabees] begins half a year before or half a year after the date usually assigned, whether in spring B.C. 312 or in spring B.C. 311... But the opinion generally accepted, that spring B.C. 312 is the starting point, can be proved to be certainly the right one" (First Division, Volume 1, pg. 44, *A History of the Jewish People in the Time of Jesus Christ*, Emil Schurer, 1890).  
The various epochs of the Seleucid era owe their origin to the various means of reckoning a year used by various city-states, some counting from spring, others from the fall, some counting inclusively, and some counting exclusively. The Anno Seleucid Judean era counts Seleucus' ante-dated accession year as the first year of the era on a spring basis. In Babylon the non-accession method was used to start the era.
