**Herod's Reign**  
 Herod's sole reign ends at 37 years (Rome), 34 years (Jewish), and he appoints his son Antipater coregent (Josephus Wars 1.632). Herod has his son executed, and lives to 1 B.C. and dies after a lunar eclipse recorded in Josephus. Rome divides Herod's kingdom, and antedates the years of Antipater's coregency to Herod Antipas and Archelaus, but not Philip.

**Birth of John the Immerser**

**Birth of Messiah, 9/1, 2 B.C.**

KJV Revelation 12:1 And there appeared a great wonder in heaven; a woman clothed with the sun, and the moon under her feet, and upon her head a crown of twelve stars: 2 And she being with child cried, travelling in birth, and pained to be delivered. (Tue/Wed, Sept. 1, 2 B.C. Yom Teruah [Trumpets]. Tishri 1, 2 B.C.)

**Eclipse of the Moon**

**Death of Herod; first Herod murders his coregent Antipater and the Bethlehem children, then he dies of disease after a lunar eclipse. Ceasar divides his kingdom and Antipater's coregency years are antedated by Antipas and Archelaus.**

**Herod Antipas: antedated reign, based on yr 44 coin.**

**Archelaus: antedated reign**

**Herod Philip, Finegan §518. Oldest copies of Jos. Ant. Read his death in 22nd yr Tiberius. Philip has coins for years 34 and 37, thus his reign began in 1 BC.**

**Archelaus banished**

KJV Luke 2:41 Now his parents went to Jerusalem every year at the feast of the passover. 42 And when he was twelve years old, they went up to Jerusalem after the custom of the feast. Passover = Wednesday 4/8/11 A.D. JP = 15 Nisan.

**Tiberius Cesar August 19th, A.D. 14 - March 16, A.D. 37. JP.**
