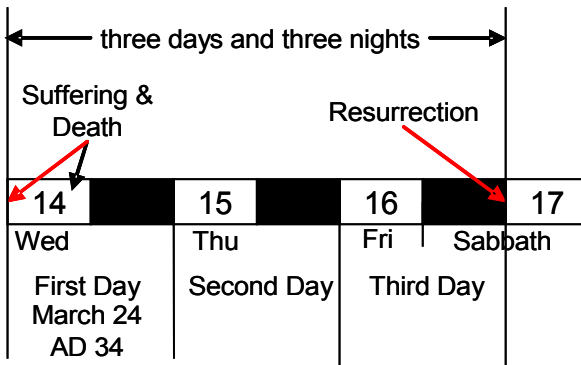

three Days and the three Nights; and *Saturday Morning*, the first Morning of the *Jewish Sabbath*<sup>10</sup>, came the Women.

Our author explains it according to the following diagram, such that the three days are Wednesday Day, Thursday Day, and Friday Day, and the three nights are Wednesday-Thu Night, Thursday-Fri Night, and Friday-Sat Night. This is to reckon the day from daybreak to daybreak:

And they came the first Morning of the Sabbath very early, not the first day of the Week, as *Sebastian* and our *English* Translators render those several Texts of Scripture.

Observe the first day is a day and a night, and the second day a day and a night, and the third day a day and a night. Thus day precedes the night, and the calendar day is a day and a night, or 24 hours. The remarkable thing is that this unknown author had it all exactly right.

<sup>10</sup> Our author is compelled to call the Sabbath the *Jewish Sabbath* because Christians were in the habit of calling Sunday the Sabbath. Only by calling it the *Jewish Sabbath* or *Saturday* can he make clear that the seventh day is meant, as even then Sunday Christians would dispute Sunday to be the seventh day, or say that no one knows.
