Ezekiel gives the figure of 390 years for the sin of Israel. This spans the time between Jeroboam's rebellion and the date of the prophecy. $|-983.7-593.7| = 390$ years. (Jeroboam was made king of the Northern Kingdom shortly after Rehoboam became king of Judah). I do not explain all the details in the intervening chronology here because the long number of 390 years verifies that it is correct. The Ezekiel 1:1 date is anchored in the astronomically verified Neo-Babylonian chronology. Since the Scripture uses dates from the reign of Nebuchadnezzar, we may assume that the astronomical foundation thereof is completely sound. Otherwise, the scripture would not use the dates. For that would be to introduce err into the Scripture.

We have secured this chronology as a result of correcting the death and resurrection of Messiah and discovering how Daniel 9 works with it. We may also show that the Jubilee cycle is correctly synchronized (see Appendix VII, page 47749).

THE GOING OUT OF EGYPT

The following chart accounts for the 480 years of 1Kings 6:1. The key to this passage is that “going out of Egypt” refers to the Passover memorial, which Israel did not observe nationally when YHWH allowed them to be oppressed by foreign nations. The 480 years does not count 134 years of foreign oppression when Israel did not observe the passover as a nation.
