6. The First day of the Omer count is also an anniversary of the resurrection of Messiah Yeshua, marked by the blue star at the end of the first Omer day. In AD 34, when Messiah was raised, the two stars were at the same time.

7. Unleavened Bread is to be eaten from sunst of the 14th day to the fall of night on the 21st day. No leaven is to be found in the house or seen in the land.

8. The Watch Night is for staying up all night, to keep watch, because YHWH kept watch over the sons of Israel to bring them out of Egypt.

9. The year of the world is 6164, year 4 of the 7 year Sabbath cycle, and year 39 of the 50 year Jubilee cycle.

1. The Omer is counted at dawn, so it is left aligned with the start of the day.

2. The first day of Passover is a Sabbath.

3. The seventh day of Passover is a Sabbath. It is in the chart twice because the evening to evening day breaks in the middle of the dawn to dawn day, but it is the same 24 hour period.

4. The small numbers at the bottom of each box, starting with 1/19, indicate the day of the week, and the day of the solar year. The large bold numbers at the top of the box are the days of the month.

5. The First of the Sabbaths is an anniversary day of the Resurrection of Messiah Yeshua, Marked by the green star on the first of the Sabbaths.
